

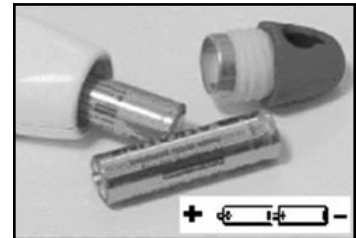
# PET NAIL FILER MANUAL

Before you begin, read ALL instructions carefully to ensure a safe and stress-free experience for you and your pet.

**KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE. WHEN PASSING THE PET NAIL FILER ON TO SOMEBODY ELSE, BE SURE TO GIVE THEM THIS MANUAL.**

## Installing Batteries:

1. Make sure the protective cap is locked on securely before installing the batteries.
2. Always use fresh batteries.
3. Unscrew the cap on the bottom of the Pet Nail Filer in an anti-clockwise direction.
4. Insert 2 AA batteries as indicated on the unit. Pay attention to the correct position of the pole (+/-) when installing the batteries.
5. Close the battery cap securely.



Follow the direction indicated on the surface of main body to install the batteries.

### NOTE:

ONLY USE THE PET NAIL FILER ON A PET YOU ARE FAMILIAR WITH.  
DO NOT PUT YOUR SAFTY AT RISK.

IF THE PET BECOMES AGGRESSIVE, STOP USING THE PET NAIL FILER IMMEDIATELY.

BEFORE USING THE PET NAIL FILER, SPEND SOME TIME PROPERLY INTRODUCING THE DEVICE TO YOUR PET. THIS WILL MAKE USING THE PET NAIL FILER MUCH EASIER ONCE IT'S TIME TO BEGIN FILING.

## How to Start?

1. Turn on the unit and give your pet a delicious treat. Move the unit close to your pet and give him or her enthusiastic praise.
2. As necessary, repeat step 1 each day until your pet is completely comfortable around the Pet Nail Filer.
3. Now turn on the Pet Nail Filer and have a treat ready. This time we will file the TIP of ONE of your pet's nails. After filing, praise and reward your pet with a treat.
4. Next, we will do one whole paw. Alternate nails and only file each nail for 2-3 seconds. When finished, reward your pet with praise and a treat.

## Trimming Your Pet's Nails:

Use the Pet Nail Filer on a soft, comfortable spot like a carpeted floor, bed or sofa.

1. Take your pet's paw and support a single nail between your thumb and forefinger. This is essential. You must always support the nail before filing. See picture to the right.
2. Always make sure the protective cap is locked on securely before filing. Turn the Pet Nail Filer on and insert a nail into the opening in the protective cap. You can find one open hole on each side of the protective cap. The bottom opening on the protective cap is good for hard nails and the top opening on the protective cap is good for soft nails. Put the nail into the opening and start gently filing the nail. File the nail for no more than 3 to 4 seconds at a time before alternating nails. Always alternate nails. This insures your pet does not experience any discomfort due to excessive friction. Always check the nail after every 3 to 4 seconds of filing. This will insure you do not file too much. Over filing can result in injury to your pet.
3. Always file in a rounded motion to give the nails a smooth blunt feel.
4. File the upper part of the nail in addition to just the bottom; this is the secret to a good Pet Nail Filer pedicure. The top portion of the nail is where most of the growth occurs and is usually the sharpest part. File the nail little by little until it is rounded and smooth.



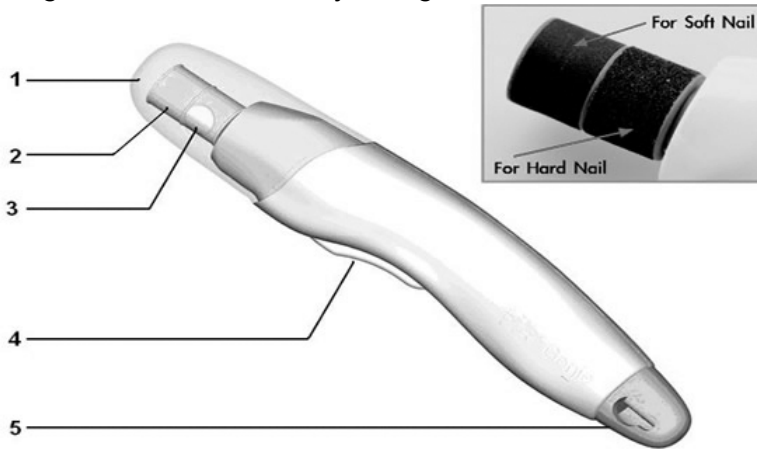
## CAUTION

**If this is your first time using the Pet Nail filer, be very careful not to file too much nail off.**

Be conservative: only round off sharp edges and obvious growths. As you and your pet become more comfortable with the Pet Nail Filer, you may try to get closer to the quick. This is the inner part of the nail, which contains nerves and a blood vessel. The reason traditional nail clipping can be so painful and bloody is because the clippers squeeze or cut through the quick. Between the hard enamel layer and the quick there is a softer leathery layer. Once you reach this layer you should stop filing. Looking at the nail from the front, you should be able to see the quick emerging from underneath the layers of enamel. Always remember to look at the nail after every 2 to 4 seconds of filing.

## After Use:

1. Always remove the batteries before opening the protective cap.
2. Empty the filings into a bin and wipe with a dry cloth.
3. Store the Pet Nail Filer in a safe, dry location and keep away from children.
4. If it will not be used again for a period of time, please do not keep the batteries inside the unit. This will avoid damage that can be caused by leakage.

## WARNING

- THE PET NAIL FILER IS NOT A TOY SO KEEP THE PRODUCT OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- ENSURE THE PROTECTIVE CAP IS SECURELY LOCKED BEFORE INSTALLING THE BATTERIES.
- THE PET NAIL FILER IS ONLY SUITABLE FOR PET'S NAILS.
- DO NOT PUT YOUR PET'S PAWS INTO THE EMERY BARREL.
- DO NOT OPEN THE PROTECTIVE CAP BEFORE REMOVING THE BATTERIES.
- DO NOT INSTALL THE BATTERIES BEFORE SNAPPING ON THE PROTECTIVE CAP.
- DO NOT OPEN THE PROTECTIVE CAP WHEN IN USE.
- PAY ATTENTION TO THE CORRECT POSITION OF THE POLES (+/-) WHEN INSTALLING THE BATTERIES.

## BATTERY WARNING

- DO NOT MIX OLD AND NEW BATTERIES.
- DO NOT MIX ALKALINE, STANDARD (CARBON-ZINC) OR RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES.
- DO NOT RECHARGE NON-RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES.
- DO NOT SHORT CIRCUIT, DISASSEMBLE, HEAT OR PUT BATTERIES INTO A FIRE.
- NEVER LET CHILDREN PLAY WITH BATTERIES AND KEEP THE BATTERIES OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- REMOVE BATTERIES FROM UNIT IF IT WILL NOT BE USED AGAIN FOR A PERIOD OF TIME. THIS PREVENTS DAMAGE OR INJURY DUE TO POTENTIAL BATTERY LEAKAGE.



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
